

North Wessex Downs AONB Photography Competition September 2016 - 31 August 2017

Term and Conditions of Entry

1. Pictures should be submitted by e-mail to info@northwessexdowns.org.uk. By submitting an entry you agree to the following terms and conditions.
2. This competition is open to UK residents only. Entrants need to be 16 years of age on 1 August 2016.
3. The email must include the name of the photographer, email and telephone contact details plus details of when and where each photograph was taken. Entries received without these details will not be included in the competition. The North Wessex Downs AONB will only ever use your personal details for the purposes of administering this competition and will not publish them or provide them to anyone without your permission.
5. This competition is only open to amateur photographers. For the purposes of this competition, an amateur is defined as a person who earns less than 50% of their annual income through the sales of their photography.
6. The entries must be submitted by the photographer and be original work and may not infringe the copyright of another person.
7. The entry must not have previously won a photography competition, nor have been offered for sale.
8. Entrants must not have breached any laws when taking their photographs.
9. Entrants retain copyright in any photographs they enter into this competition. All entrants grant a non-exclusive, perpetual, royalty-free licence to the North Wessex Downs AONB Partnership. No fees will be payable for these uses.
10. A maximum of two entries will be accepted per person per round.
11. The closing date for receipt of entries for the first round is 30 November 2016. The final date for round 4 entries will be 31 August 2017. Closing dates for rounds 2 and 3 will be published during the course of the competition.
12. There will be a prize for the winner of each round and the three best images from each round will be entered into the final which will be judged at the end of the fourth round in September 2017.

14. Judging will be undertaken by a panel of two or three people to include a representative from the North Wessex Downs AONB Partnership, professional photographer Mark Lord (<http://www.marklordphotography.co.uk>) and may include a representative from the sponsor providing the prize. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

15. By taking part in the competition, you will be expected to take part in any publicity associated with the competition.

16. By submitting your photograph to the North Wessex Downs AONB you agree to your name being published in relation to your photograph online and in all media

17. This competition is not open to any person involved in the running of the competition, or their immediate family members.

18. North Wessex Downs AONB reserves the right to cancel this competition at any stage.

19. If a winning entrant is unable to be contacted after reasonable attempts have been made to do so, the North Wessex Downs AONB reserves the right to offer the prize to the next best entry.

20. The North Wessex Downs AONB Partnership reserves the right to disqualify any entry which breaches any of these rules or to withhold a prize if in its opinion entries do not reach the required standard.
